

# West River BUILD Project

Tampa Multimodal Network and Safety Improvements

## Pre-Construction Public Information Meeting

Segment 1 will provide approximately 0.2 miles of two new pedestrian underpass bridges and a newly constructed multi-use trail from Bayshore Boulevard (immediately south of the Platt Street Bridge) north and to the existing West Riverwalk at Arabelle Riverwalk Apartments, north of Brorein Street. This segment links Bayshore Boulevard to Tony Jannus Park and north to the Arabelle Riverwalk Apartments. *(See map on back.)*



### KEY COMMUNITY BENEFITS



Wide (15-foot clear width) pedestrian underpass bridges under Platt and Brorein Streets



15-foot wide multi-use concrete trail and pedestrian overlook at Tony Jannus Park



"Dark Skies" friendly trail lighting



### PROJECT FUNDING

The design-build project cost is \$56,855,530. The project is being funded by local and federal sources, including a \$24 million Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) Grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and a \$10,000,000 Community Redevelopment Award.

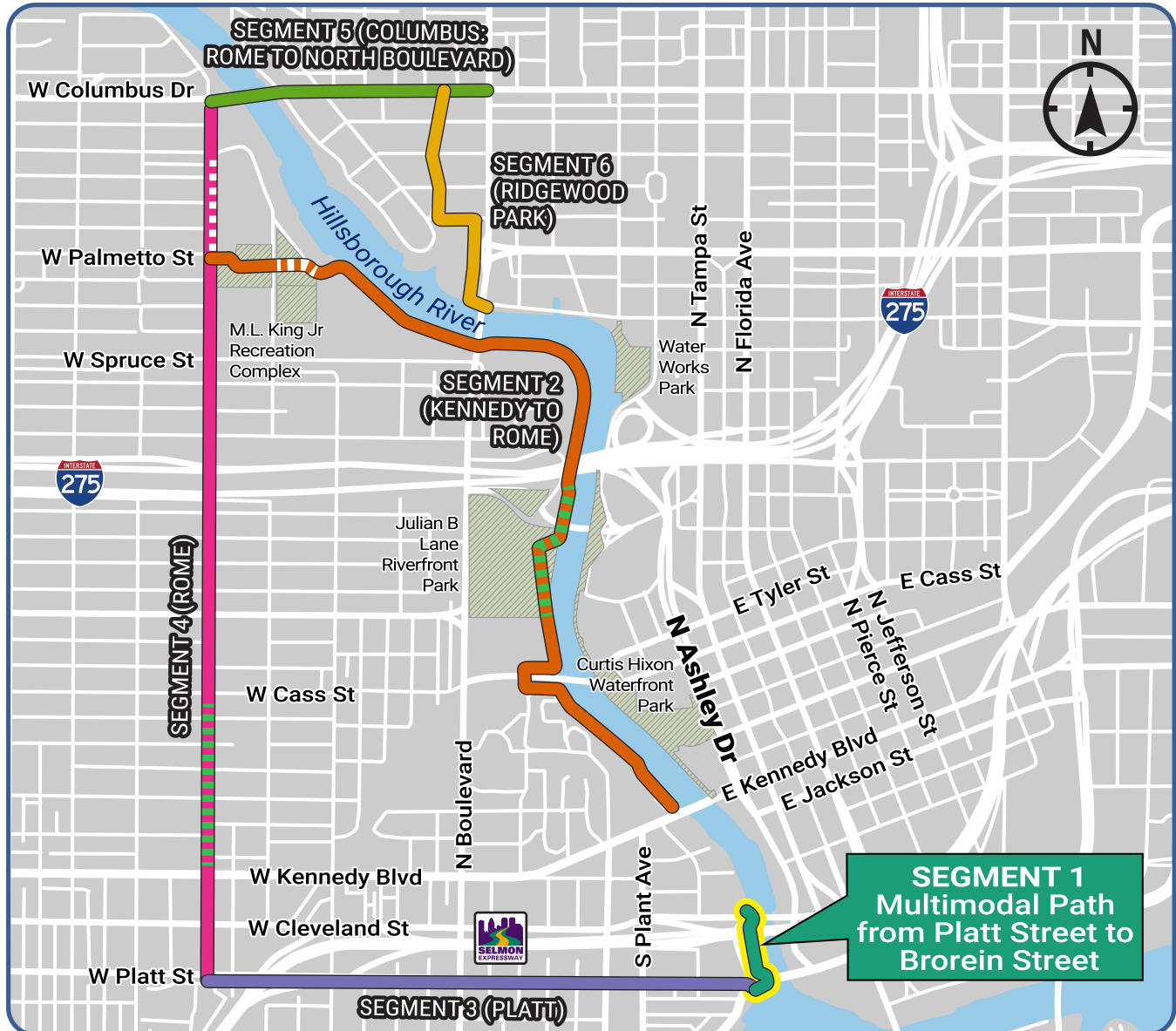
