## **West River BUILD Project**

Tampa Multimodal Network and Safety Improvements

**Pre-Construction Public Information Meeting** 

Segment 6 will provide approximately 0.4 miles of a bicycle boulevard on Glenwood Drive, a new multimodal trail, and safety enhancements in the Ridgewood Park neighborhood. These improvements will extend along Glenwood Drive from West Columbus Drive to a new, special-emphasis crosswalk at Ross Avenue. Segment 6 will ultimately connect with the existing East Riverwalk on West 7th Avenue. (See map on back.)



### **KEY COMMUNITY BENEFITS**



New bicycle boulevard with shared lane markings and bollards on North Glenwood Drive



New high-emphasis crosswalk with pedestrian beacon at Ross Avenue crossing to Glenwood Drive



New 12-foot wide concrete, multi-use trail along North Boulevard and crosswalk at 7th Avenue connecting to existing Riverwalk



Americans with Disability Act (ADA) enhancements



"Dark Skies" friendly trail lighting



New 12-foot wide concrete, multi-use trail along the south side of Ross Avenue



### PROJECT FUNDING

The design-build project cost is \$56,855,530. The project is being funded by local and federal sources, including a \$24 million Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) Grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and a \$10,000,000 Community Redevelopment Award.
