Tampa Multimodal Network and Safety Improvements

AUGUST 2026

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

As part of the **West River BUILD Project**, the contractor is scheduled to start on Segment 3B (*see Project Overview below*). A traffic shift will be implemented on the south side of West Platt Street, from South Willow Avenue to South Magnolia Avenue, with the north lane closed to traffic. This work is expected to begin on **Wednesday, August 26, 2026**. Roadwork and repaving will be underway during this time; motorists should drive with caution as uneven roadway surfaces are expected. (*See Project Area Map on back for work location.*) Construction activities for Segment 3B will **continue through September 2026**.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- ✓ **Hours of operation:** Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- ✓ **Overnight Work (as needed):** Construction near the Selmon Expressway off-ramp at West Platt Street may occur overnight (approximately 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.) to meet agency requirements and reduce traffic impacts.
- ✓ Staging of construction equipment and materials in public right-of-way areas.
- ✓ Construction noise, dust, and increased presence of construction workers and equipment.
- ✓ Temporary lane closures, detours, and minor traffic delays.
- ✓ No anticipated interruptions to mail, garbage/recycling services.

PROPERTY ACCESS:

Driveway access will be maintained for most homes and businesses; however, some locations may experience **temporary driveway closures** during sidewalk and curb reconstruction. Please plan to use nearby street parking if needed. Pedestrian access will be maintained, and emergency services will always have access. Business accesses are to be maintained and coordinated with the property owner.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Segment 3B includes Complete Street improvements designed to enhance safety, accessibility, and traffic flow in the area. Planned improvements include:

- Resurfacing of existing pavement
- Sidewalk upgrades and accessibility improvements
- Installation of a one-way eastbound protected cycle track along the south side of West Platt Street

This segment will provide a dedicated, low-stress connection from South Rome Avenue through Hyde Park to the riverfront.
